

# Gender Studies E-book Collection 2018 Pricing Information

The **Gender Studies e-book collection** includes essential titles and field-defining scholarship in queer theory, gay and lesbian studies, transgender studies, feminist theory, and women's studies. The collection is available through purchase or annual lease. Download the title list at *dukeupress.edu/library*.

These e-books are DRM-free and allow unlimited, simultaneous, multiuser access.

# **Access Options**

### **Purchase the Collection**

Purchase includes perpetual access to over 500 Gender Studies e-books. In subsequent years, purchasing libraries will have the option to "top up" their subject collection by buying the year's new batch of relevant titles. The 2018 collection includes the original collection presented in 2016 of over 500 e-books as well as titles published in 2017.

### **Annual Lease**

Annual lease provides one calendar year of access (January to December 2018) to the Gender Studies collection. For 2018, this includes over 500 titles. To maintain access after 2018, libraries will need to purchase the collection or renew the lease.

### Lease to Own

Libraries that lease the Gender Studies collection for five consecutive years are automatically **upgraded to perpetual access** to the collection.

### **Features of the Collection**

- DRM-free: users can print, read online, and download PDFs by chapter
- unlimited multiuser access
- tiered discounting
- COUNTER-compliant usage statistics
- free MARC catalog records
